It was an absolute joy to go in the ring with him. We frequently got comments on the joy we had while in the ring competing. That, to me, is what it is all about.....

I have competed in obedience, agility, rally, tracking, hunt tests, freestyle, scent work and conformation. One of my proudest moments was winning the 20" Preferred Class at the 2011 AKC National Agility Championships with my then 11-year-old Golden Retriever Devon. While I love to compete with my dogs, I feel the most important aspect in training is to have a strong relationship and bond. My goals in training my dogs and helping you to train yours are to cultivate and nurture that bond and to have FUN while doing it!"
